Eligibility & Application Requirements:

- Open to graduating high school seniors from any school.
- Applicants may use the scholarship for any post-secondary education program, including:
- Trade schools
- Community colleges
- Two-year and four-year college programs

Preference is given to:

- Students residing in the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District (TESD).
- Students whose parent or guardian is affiliated with BDBA, either as a business owner or an employee of a BDBA-member business.

Application Materials:

Applicants must submit the following:

1. Cover Letter (1-page maximum):

- Explain why you should be awarded the scholarship.
- Describe your academic achievements and future goals.
- Highlight your community service and extracurricular involvement.
- State your intended college, university, or trade school.

2. Resume:

- Education: Include high school name, graduation year, and GPA (if applicable).
- Work Experience: List part-time jobs, internships, or summer employment.
- Extracurricular Activities: Include clubs, sports, hobbies, performing arts, or other school-related activities.
- Volunteer Activities: Highlight any community service, charity work, or civic engagement.
- Special Skills: Note any notable talents, certifications, or additional achievements.

3. School Transcript(s):

- Provide a copy of your high school transcript.
- If your current transcript covers only one to two years, include an additional transcript from previous years.

Application Submission & Deadline:

• Deadline: Applications must be received by April 15, 2025.

Evaluation Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed and scored based on the following:

- 1. Parent/caregiver affiliation with BDBA (15 points): Applicants whose parents or guardians are affiliated with BDBA receive preference.
- 2. Residency & Graduation Status (10 points): Preference is given to students living in TESD who are graduating in June, including private school graduates.
- 3. Quality of Cover Letter (15 points): Applicants are evaluated on writing quality and how well they address the required topics.
- 4. Academic Performance (30 points): GPA and rigor of coursework, including honors and AP classes, are considered.
- 5. Extracurricular Activities (10 points): Participation in clubs, hobbies, performing arts, sports, and other interests is evaluated.
- 6. Volunteer Activities (10 points): Community service and civic engagement play a key role in the evaluation process.
- 7. Work Experience (10 points): Employment history is taken into account.
